In honor of the wedding of our children, Rabbi Levi Yitzchok and Sarah Rivka Cunin, we have decided to publish a select group of correspondence and other matters of interest from our family's archives.

This is only a small portion of our vast family treasures of our family that date back to the relationship between our grandfather, Rabbi Menachem Mendel Cunin, and the Previous Lubavitcher Rebbe, Schneerson, HK" M. Indeed every time the Rebbe would write my grandfather he would refer to him as "My dear friend". It was my grandfather who was one of the founders of Agudas Chassidim Chabad, the Chabad Lubavitch Organization, and helped purchase 770, the headquarters of the Chabad Lubavitch Movement.

Among the letters included in this presentation is a personal invitation addressed to my grandfather. Inviting him to attend the wedding of the Previous Rebbe's daughter, Chaya Mushka, to the present Rebbe, Rabbi Menachem Mendel Cunin was not only from the closest Chassidim of the Rebbe, but also one of the greatest financial supporters of the Chabad Lubavitch movement first in Europe and then in America.

He supported all of the Rebbe's institutions and gave charity sacrificially. As the well-known story is told, family members came to ask the Previous Rebbe to tell my grandfather to stop his practice of giving all the money he had to charity, and then sending his wife, my grandmother Sarah Rivka (the Kallah, by Divine Providence, bears her name), to borrow money from the local kosher butcher, Mr. Price, to be able to buy the family food for Shabbos. The Rebbe replied, "here is nothing I can do to stop a man who's right hand is a vessel for G-d's kindness."

This tradition has been carried on by his children, grandchildren and great grandchildren, who have all remained Torah true Jews, and supporters of the Chabad Lubavitch Movement. Indeed my parents, and especially my mother Rochel ob"m, had a very personal and special relationship with the Rebbe. The Rebbe wrote many letters to my mother with handwritten side notes, which will be published, with G-d's help, for future simechas of our children.

The greatest blessing the Rebbe has given me and my family over the last 30 years of our service to him in California, has been the blessing of overcoming all obstacles. May G-d help that we shall utilize this blessing to overcome all obstacles in bringing about the redemption of the Rebbe's holy books from Russia. May we merit to overcome the greatest obstacle of all, the terrible suffering of this world in the throes of the last moments of exile.
